### GENERAL INFORMATION

The Fall Semester begins approximately on August 15th of each calendar year, and is divided into two eight-week terms; the second term begins approximately on October 15th of each calendar year. The Spring Semester begins approximately on January 1st of each calendar year, and is divided into two eight-week terms; the second term begins approximately on March 1st. The Summer Semester (summer term) begins in May and lasts for eight weeks. For specific information of class times, please refer to the class schedule. Courses are offered on-line; selected courses will be filmed live and offered on campus on Monday and Tuesday evenings

### FINANCIAL INFORMATION

There is a tuition charge of \$500 for each course (\$600 for each graduate course). There is a discounted tuition charge of \$250 (\$300, graduate course) for each audit course or for senior citizens 60 years old and older (credit or audit). Scholarships are available for credit courses. A student must pay off his or her bill from the previous semester(s) before being allowed to register for a new semester of work.
